- Designed and led implementation of conversational coaching feature, fulfilling contractual obligations and increasing sales leads. Mentored and ramped up a junior engineer on the project.
- Led efforts to increase scaling of the product. Identified and fixed key bottlenecks using PostgreSQL analyze, ran load testing, and scaled the main metrics feature to 10x the users. This effort unblocked the largest sale opportunity of the company at the time.
